

Gold Medal

How to nominate

A nomination may be for one person or for a group of persons. You may submit one or more nominations for the medal. To make a nomination, please submit (for each) a typed statement, not exceeding two pages, stating:

- The medal for which the nomination is being made.
- The justification for the nomination in terms of the criteria set for the medal for which the nomination is being made.
- The essential biographical details on the nominee(s) (name, date and place of birth, formal education, career highlights).
- A description of the main achievements of the nominee(s) and, if relevant to a nomination for the Gold Medal, a description of the event. Your name, address and telephone number, as the person making the nomination.
- A nominee's curriculum vitae and a bibliography of his/her principal published works should also be included. Book length submissions, however, are discouraged.

The Committee will keep all nominations under consideration for a period of three years. Properly documented nominations received at the Society's office by close of business on **March 1** will be considered in awarding medals for the following year.
